1 Introduction

1.1 Objectives and activities of the CH4LLENGE project

The overall objective of CH4LLENGE was to develop innovative, practically proven and transferable solutions to the four most pressing common challenges of sustainable urban mobility planning and to support cities at different stages of advancement in the take-up of Sustainable Urban Mobility Plans (SUMPs). The project aimed to determine strategies to overcoming SUMP challenges related to the participation of citizens and stakeholders, cooperation between institutional partners, selection of measures and measure packages as well as monitoring and evaluation. Focus of the project was on the elaboration of a SUMP, i.e. the steps, methodologies and approaches required for sustainable urban mobility planning leading to a quality mobility plan.

CH4LLENGE aimed to actively facilitate the take-up of SUMPs in European cities and therefore provided its nine Partner Cities and 26 Follower Cities with a dedicated SUMP workshop series and, for the latter the opportunity to jointly develop SUMP roadmaps to kick-off or progress in SUMP development. In addition, CH4LLENGE intended to enhance the capacities of planners working in local authorities by developing a comprehensive capacity building programme and, finally, capturing all knowledge gained in four extensive CH4LLENGE Kits.

The main activities that have taken place during the project are the following:

- Generating, consolidating and capturing knowledge on the four challenges
- Testing innovative SUMP process solutions at local level
- Strengthening SUMP capacities in European planning authorities

1.2 Objectives of dissemination activities

The CH4LLENGE partner Union of the Baltic Cities Commission on Environment (UBC) was in charge of the project's dissemination activities. UBC was supported by project coordinator Rupprecht Consult. The overall objectives of the dissemination work package were

- to showcase the learning experience CH4LLENGE cities and its associated Follower Cities would go through,
- to spread project results widely in order to accelerate the take-up of SUMPs among cities and regions across Europe and especially in New Member States,
- to promote the SUMP approach,
- to develop a concept how to record all dissemination activities during the project phase at project and city level, and
- to disseminate the four CH4LLENGE Kits and other relevant project outputs.

Agreed deliverables of this work package were: D7.1 Communication plan, D7.2 Online portal, D7.3 Leaflet and D7.4 Dissemination report. In addition, CH4LLENGE forsaw the following outputs of dissemination activities:

- Social media SUMP network groups
- Wikipedia online dictionary entry on SUMP
- SUMP mobile application



- CH4LLENGE project identity: logo, common style templates
- Roll-ups (twelve in total, two on the project in general, two on the challenges and one localised roll-up per city)
- Promotion of the project at eight European or national events
- European, national and local press releases
- Articles in professional media (one per year in English)
- CH4LLENGE Ambassador presenting the project at additional external events
- Glossy production of final publishable report and four CH4LLENGE Kits each consisting of a quick-facts brochure, manual and an e-learning course

2 Project communication plan

The CH4LLENGE Communication Plan (D7.1) was prepared in July 2013 and updated in August 2014. This strategy document was the framework for all activities and work to be accomplished within the dissemination work package. It defined which dissemination channels at European, national and local levels were planned to be used, which project milestones provided excellent opportunities for communication and outreach, and which possible external networking opportunities and events CH4LLENGE could liaise with. Further to this, it set out a strategy how the CH4LLENGE project would contribute to raising awareness and stimulating the exploitation and widespread use of the SUMP concept across Europe. Dissemination activities set out in the communication plan included the following:

- Project communication tools
 - Online platform
 - Web 2.0 applications
 - CH4LLENGE leaflet
 - Glossy production of final publishable report, quick-facts brochure and manuals
 - CH4LLENGE roll-ups and wind banners
 - CH4LLENGE visual outlook
- Events
 - National and local events
 - European events
- Promotion and dissemination
- CH4LLENGE Ambassador

The following chapters summarise the main activities that took place within these different categories.



3 Project communication tools

3.1 Online platform

The online platform www.sump-challenges.eu (D7.2) was set up in autumn 2013 and updated several times. It served as the main project gateway to the outside world and will sustain after the project's end for at least two years. The website was visited 19.408 times by 13.024 unique users (as of 3 June 2016). On average 2,3 pages were viewed per visit and the average duration of one session was a bit more than two minutes. Approximately half of the visitors clicked to at least one another page on the website. The home page was visited the most (approx. 8.000 times), followed by the 'Monitoring and Evaluation' page (approx. 6.000 times). The pages 'About', 'Participation', 'Partners' and 'Events' were visited each approx. 2.000 times. CH4LLENGE documents have been downloaded from the website in total 2.470 times, with the following top four documents:

- Guidelines for developing and implementing a Sustainable Urban Mobility Plan (524 downloads)
- 2. Challenge Description "Why is Monitoring and Evaluation a challenge in sustainable urban mobility planning?" (229 downloads)
- 3. Challenge Description "Why is Participation a challenge in sustainable urban mobility planning?" (192 downloads)
- 4. CH4LLENGE leaflet (138 downloads)

Most visitors to the website came from Germany (861), followed by Poland (790), UK (785), Romania (721), Czech Republic (653), Hungary (572), Italy (510) and Belgium (489).

The website provides all public documents produced in CH4LLENGE, categorised into an overview section, tools for SUMP development, SUMP knowledge resources, city-related outputs, documentation of training and learning activities and project management outputs.

3.2 Web 2.0 activities

The following web 2.0 activities have taken place to publish news of the project, inform about CH4LLENGE events and disseminate the results of the project to the wider group of professionals and other actors interested in the field of sustainable mobility:

- A <u>CH4LLENGE LinkedIn Group</u> was created which has 56 members. In total, 34 posts were published. The LinkedIn group aimed to exchange with Partner and Follower Cities, but also other interested mobility practitioners were invited to join
- A CH4LLENGE Twitter account was established that had 242 followers by the end of the project; a total of 129 tweets were posted

To give the idea of the SUMP concept a real boost and initiate knowledge consolidation, a Wikipedia article on Sustainable Urban Mobility Plans has been submitted to the Wikipedia Board. The article will be approved and published in the second half of 2016.



It was foreseen to develop a mobile application about sustainable urban mobility planning. However, it was decided to omit this activity as the requirements for developing a tool of real added value exceeded the skills and capacities of the project team. Producing a low-cost app of little value was not considered desirable.

3.3 CH4LLENGE project leaflet

An English project leaflet (D7.3) was produced by UBC EnvCom (design) and RC (text) as electronic and print versions. The leaflet presents the project at a glance, describes its aims and activities and introduces the SUMP methodology.

Partner cities translated the leaflet into the eight project languages (CZ, DE, FR, HR, HU, NL, PL, RO). A total of 1.000 English leaflets and 200 of each language version were printed and distributed by the consortium at relevant SUMP events.



3.4 CH4LLENGE Kits

The four CH4LLENGE Kits consist each of a quick-facts brochure and a manual (as well as an e-learning course). UBC had first designed a CH4LLENGE-based theme and template for the SUMP Kits. When the SUMP Co-ordinating Group decided to give the Kits the official SUMP platform branding, layout works had to be adapted accordingly. The CH4LLENGE-based design was then used for the publishable final report.

Content for the quick-facts brochures were developed in WPs2-5, while their design was taken care of by UBC in WP7. This included designing the four English brochures as well as 32 translations. In all, 11.500 copies of the brochures were printed by UBC. All 36 brochures are also available as electronic version on the CH4LLENGE and Eltis websites.

In a similar process, four manuals were developed in WPs 2-5 and designed by UBC in WP7. It was planned to develop only manuals for the participation, cooperation and monitoring and evaluation challenges. During the course of the project, the consortium recognised the need to close the gap in the manual series and produced an additional manual on measure selection, which was not translated. Therefore, UBC designed four English manuals and 24 translations. Printing of manuals was originally not foreseen. As the manuals presented new quality SUMP resources, RC successfully submitted a funding request to CIVITAS









CAPITAL to print 2.400 copies of the manuals. A third was distributed at the 3rd Annual SUMP Conference, another third will be distributed at the CIVITAS Forum Conference in September and the last third was sent to Consortium partners for dissemination in their countries. Electronic versions of the manuals are also available on the CH4LLENGE and Eltis websites.

RC oversaw the overall coordination of the translation process for the Kits. Partner Cities managed the selection of a translation company for their language, the contact with translators, contract management as well as quality control.

As part of final reporting, RC developed a 24-page glossy, publishable report presenting the lessons learned and impacts achieved in CH4LLENGE. The report was designed by UBC and is available on the project website for download.





3.5 Final publishable report

As part of final reporting, RC developed a 28-page glossy, publishable report presenting the lessons learned and impacts achieved in CH4LLENGE. The report was designed by UBC and is available on the project website for download. 1000 copies were printed.





3.6 CH4LLENGE roll-ups and wind banners

For promotion at European, national and local events, twelve roll-ups were produced. City partners agreed at the Leeds Consortium Meeting that they prefer roll-ups over wind banners as experience has shown that roll-ups are more suitable for events. It was decided to produce one roll-up in the local language per city (except for WYCA) containing city-specific information and two copies of two different general project roll-ups, one introducing the project and showing the Partner Cities on a map, another one explaining the four challenges.



3.7 CH4LLENGE visual outlook

To generate a clear CH4LLENGE project identity for all public communication tools, a corporate identity including a meaningful project logo and common style templates (report template, PowerPoint template) were designed. CH4LLENGE produced three versions of the logo. The official, full version of the logo (A) was used in all project publications and other published dissemination material. The shorter logo (B) was used whenever there was less space available e.g. in different social media groups. The short version was accompanied, when possible, with the text *Addressing Key Challenges of Sustainable Urban Mobility Planning*. The third version (C) was used whenever there was enough space to have the logo in larger size (e.g. PowerPoint presentation). Clear guidelines how to use logos have been provided to partners.

UBC developed an adapted the logo for CH4LLENGE Universities, which was used for all related documents and activities. UBC also adapted the website, organised registration and various promotional material for the CH4LLENGE Universities.

For online learning, UBC developed a specific icon, which was used for all courses and related activities. UBC supported the online learning further with adapting the website and creating registration tools and promoting the events.





A photo database with high quality photos has been collected during the project. The photos were mainly from CH4LLENGE cities and used for e.g. the online portal, leaflets, brochures and manuals.

4 Project dissemination activities

4.1 Promotion of the SUMP Kits

The four SUMP Kits are the most concrete and visible results of the project. The Kits consist each of a quick fact brochure, a manual and an e-learning course. Particularly the manuals can be considered new European reference guidance to tackle the most common challenges of the SUMP process. Their design is in line with that of the SUMP platform, meaning that they look very appealing and professional and attract attention from various target groups. Since the manuals were produced at the end of the project, the active distribution and dissemination of the Kits took place in the project's final phase and during the months after it had ended.

The Kits have been intensively promoted, for example, on the CH4LLENGE website, in news items, articles and presentations at events. Having the cover pages available beforehand helped to build the brand for the CH4LLENGE Kits a couple of weeks before their actual launch. The pre-announcement and actual announcements of the CH4LLENGE Kits took place via the following portals and networks: ENDURANCE, ALLINX, PASTA, UBC, ELTIS, CIVITAS, Eurocities, POLIS and ICLEI. In addition, intensified social media posting took place before and after the publication of the Kits.

Distribution of the printed quick-fact brochures and manuals took place during spring and summer 2016, most notably at the third SUMP Conference in Bremen. In addition, all partners have distributed them in their local networks and events. UBC will continue disseminating the SUMP Kits where possible in its city network of approximately 100 cities in the Baltic region. As part of the CIVITAS DYN@MO project, where UBC is responsible for the dissemination activities, two Competence Centres on SUMP were established (Baltic Sea Region Competence Centre on SUMP and Southeast Competence Centre on SUMP). CH4LLENGE quick-fact brochures and manuals have been and will be distributed via these centres, both online and with hard copies. In addition, it is expected that the involved SUMP trainers will adjust their material based on the outcomes of the CH4LLENGE project.

4.2 Publications

CH4LLENGE partners have widely promoted the project in articles and publications during the action duration and even beyond that. More than 25 articles were published in scientific magazines, newsletters, blogs and websites. Further, CH4LLENGE Partner Cities have published news from the project and related activities in more than 45 occasions in local media (e.g. local newspapers, newsletters, public information magazines, videos).

CH4LLENGE submitted more than ten news items to the Eltis portal. In addition, project findings were presented in professional media and through other SUMP projects' communication tools.

The main publication activities are outlined in **Appendix 1**.



4.3 Events

CH4LLENGE partners promoted the project at about 60 European and 40 national events. In addition, CH4LLENGE partners carried out around 40 local events in order to promote the project and its activities in their cities and regions. Most of the local events were organised by Partner Cities, e.g. as part of their pilot projects. In **Appendix 2** the main European and national events are listed. On SharePoint, a comprehensive overview of agendas and the presentations given by partners can be found.

4.4 Project updates

Along the course of the project, CH4LLENGE has gathered a common contact database of 84 persons and organisations interested in the project. This database has been used to promote and distribute the project with two e-updates (20.11.2013 and 1.3.2015). Several support partners and partner cities have contributed to the content of the e-update. All partners have been requested to use the e-update to promote the project.

4.5 CH4LLENGE ambassador

CH4LLENGE Ambassador Wojciech Suchorzewski widely promoted the project and its findings at international, European and national conferences, workshops and seminars. He advocated the importance of sustainable urban mobility planning at a total of 19 events and spread the project's SUMP messages in several articles.

Annex 3 presents a list of Ambassador activities during the three years of the project. In addition, the CH4LLENGE Ambassador shared his valuable observations on the project in several consortium meetings.



4.6 National and local dissemination activities

As part of the CH4LLENGE project, Partner Cities implemented twelve pilot schemes related to their SUMP processes. Most of the pilot actions involved active involvement of institutional partners, citizens and stakeholders such transport providers, NGOs, scientists, researchers and businesses. Active dissemination and communication about the objectives and results of these pilots resulted in an increased knowledge and wider acceptance towards the SUMP at local and national level. During local and national dissemination activities CH4LLENGE ouputs such as the leaflets, brochures and manuals as well as other SUMP knowledge resources (e.g. online learning, SUMP Glossary, SUMP Self-Assessment) were widely disseminated.

A short overview of dissemination highlights in Partner Cities is provided below. Appendix 1 and 2 present further information on partners' local and national events and released publications.

The City of Amiens carried out a great number of dissemination activities at the beginning of the project in particular. This included articles in the city newsletter and on the website of the local authority. The SUMP concept, the city's mobility plan and relevant issues related to the four challenges were presented at a SUMP roadshow that was held in Amiens' communities.



In the City of Budapest, BKK representatives held several presentations at different local and national events on their SUMP initiatives. Active participation and openness towards new ideas by local and national stakeholders was a main achievement of this. They started to understand that the development of an SUMP was a very desirable missing element in the transport planning in Budapest in terms of cooperation, integration and synergy.

The City of Brno developed an entire SUMP brand with a great variety of communication material for their SUMP development process in order to promote the SUMP concept and encourage the city's citizens and stakeholders to actively participate in plan development.

In the City of Dresden, stakeholders, institutional partners, politicians, the city's Scientific Advisory Board and steering group were reached mainly through CH4LLENGE information provided and presentations held at workshops and Round Table meetings.

In the City of Ghent, press releases and public debates were dominated by topics related to the SUMP. Debate evenings and public inquiries about the Parking Plan, Circulation Plan and Speed Plan attracted hundreds of citizens and stakeholders. Together with lots of smaller meetings with different kinds of stakeholders, these participation events had a strong influence on the final result of the SUMP. Also national press reported in detail on the progress of the city's SUMP.

The City of Krakow disseminated the CH4LLENGE project and SUMP concept, for example, at a Polish scientific conference and several CIVINET events. The city showcased its pilot project to various other Polish cities.

In the City of Timisoara, the project was presented at several national events to transport professionals, transport operators and municipalities. Also a database was formed with stakeholders interested in the SUMP concept. CH4LLENGE partner PUT focussed its local dissemination activities specifically on BSc and MSc students of the Polcytechnical University of Timisoara.

In the City of Zagreb, the CH4LLENGE project was promoted during e.g. the city's Energy Week, European Mobility Week and in several workshops for citizens and local stakeholders. Promotional material and an info brochure were produced.
