CALL FOR ENTRIES

Many local authorities and organisations are undertaking initiatives toward seamless mobility in Europe. The INTERREG Northwest Europe cluster project SYNAPTIC's **SYNAPTIC Awards for Excellence in Seamless Mobility** recognises initiatives leading toward seamless mobility in Europe. If you have implemented an innovative mobility initiative, this is your opportunity to gain recognition (and win a great prize!) for your work.

HOW TO ENTER: Submit a description of your initiative in the form of a case study to the [Eltis website](#) (note you must create a log-in to enter).

ELIGIBILITY: all case studies fitting in one of the 3 categories below and submitted to Eltis between 1 January and 31 December 2012 are eligible to win.

Categories:

1. The best multimodal door-to-door travel solution (Eltis category: Intermodality)
2. The best public transport solution (Eltis category: Collective passenger transport)
3. The best mobility management solution (Eltis category: Mobility management)

ENTRY DEADLINE: 31 December 2012 (*If your case study was published on Eltis in one of the relevant categories anytime in 2012, you don't need to enter again; you are automatically eligible*).

CRITERIA:

The awards will be granted based on the following criteria:

- Innovative (in all its forms) character
- Focus on the passenger perspective
- Effectiveness
- Level and quality of stakeholder involvement
- Appropriateness to the local context
- Leads to or demonstrates seamless mobility
- Value for money
- Use of available data

PRIZES: Free travel, accommodation and registration for the [ECOMM 2013 conference](#) in Gävle, Sweden (29-31 May 2013) will be provided to two representatives of the organisation(s) responsible for the activity described in each winning entry plus a brochure describing the initiatives.
